## Review of December16<sup>th</sup>Action Items

Lodge Feedback:

- Nic and Shawna met with local businesses. Some concerns were brought up due to certain contractors no longer staying at the Elkford Motor Inn. The numbers have been down the last month. Nic suggested meeting with them on a quarterlybasis to go over theimumbers. Elkford Motor Inn provided Nic the name of the contractor no longer staying there.
- Nic mentioned another item, just in case some of us are asked. Be very discreet with this
  information. There was a lodge resident found deceased in his room. He did not show up for
  breakfast, or pick up, or work, coworkers came back and asked to check on him and found him
  deceased. This is now an RCMP matter. Rob mentioned the RCMP did not see this as an
  environmental matter in terms of the Lodge. The only other information shared was that he is
  24 years old, found on January 3<sup>rd</sup> at 8:46am.

- There are currently 346 workers staying at the lodge, with a capacity of 486. 178 of these are FRO WTFS.
- The Lodge should be full from tomorrow to the end of spring.
- Leala asked for stats to record vs emergency stats. Ryan will provide them tomorrow.
- Lori Hucik How many projects are in there? Ryan replied 2 right now. WTF and EVO's 9M.

Medical FAQ poster boards:

• Leala needs to connect with Stefania, Ryan will provide her with the contact information by email.

Speed Spies:

• Nothing has been done on that, the team has really struggled since Destiny left and will likely not get any better until April when a maternity leave employee comes back. Suzanne offered to support in the interim and her support was gratefully accepted.

No concerns regarding the December16<sup>th</sup> minutes were raised.

**Decision:**December16<sup>th</sup> meeting minutes were accepted by the committee.

#### New Business

Elkford Emergency Room Stats:

- Leala handed out a summary of stats for the past 20 months. She would like to collect the same information from Femie and Sparwood. She thought there would be an upward trend but not seeing it. She is finding Lodge people are bypassing Elkford to go straight to Fernie. Maybe the picture will be different and we might see a trend with 1 year or more of stats. Rob asked when we got to capacity at the Lodge as he reviewed the stats, Ryan replied early July. Again, Leala expected the numbers to be on the rise but not seeing that. Leala is working on getting the WCB visits as well.
- One of the factors possibly affecting the Elkford clinic numbers might be that the doctors are not accepting new patients causing people to have to go to emergency. Again, visits not necessarily from the Lodge.
- Rob Teck workers from out of Elkford are not separate from the other number so this may not be only Lodge people.
- Kathryn: How do we determine how many non-Elkford residents are still Teck vs Lodge residents. Leala said they are not comfortable asking if they are a contractor or Teck employee.
- Duncan McDonald: If a Cranbrook resident is working at FRO are they not counted as not contractors? Leala indicated there isno way to know that unless it comes up in conversation or they notice the address on the forms.

In summary, there is currently no way to determine how many of the non-Elkford residents are from the
